LIFE SUPPORT PROTECTION

It is very important to let us know if you or someone at your address uses a Life support machine. To register your life support equipment, please call us on 1300 110 100, or email us at contact@flipped.energy. Alternatively, you can also let your distributor know and they will inform us.

Eligible Life Support Machines

- an oxygen concentrator
- an intermittent peritoneal dialysis machine
- a kidney dialysis machine
- crigler najjar syndrome phototherapy equipment
- a ventilator for life support
- any other equipment (whether fuelled by electricity or gas) that a registered medical practitioner certifies is required for a person residing at the customer's premises for life support

What you need to do

- We will send you a medical confirmation form. You'll need to get a registered medical practitioner to complete and sign the medical confirmation form and return it us within the requested time frame.
- Please let us know if you require more time to return the form, so that we can provide you with some extension.

Planed/ Unplanned power outages

 Planned power outages are sometimes necessary for maintenance or system upgrades. If you've notified us that you rely on a life support machine, either we or your energy distributor will provide written notice in advance of any scheduled outage. However, unplanned outages may still occur due to unexpected events, such as severe weather or traffic accidents.

Preparing for unexpected power outages

Regardless of whether a power outage is planned or unexpected, we strongly recommend having an action plan in place to ensure your life support machine continues to operate safely and reliably.

- Make sure to set a reminder to check the backup battery of your life support equipment, ensuring it's fully charged and ready for use when needed.
- Keep your phone fully charged and, if available, sign up for power outage alerts from your electricity distributor.
- Have essential contact information readily available, including the names, addresses, and phone numbers of your doctor, the nearest hospital, a neighbour, or someone nearby who can assist you if needed.
- Make advance arrangements with your Medical Practitioner or a nearby hospital in case of an emergency or a prolonged power outage.
